

Pre-Treatment Instructions CO2 Ablative Laser <u>without</u> PRP

PRESCRIBED MEDICATION TO BE USED PRIOR TO LASER PROCEDURE

1. Acyclovir: Begin using the Acyclovir/Valtrex one day prior to your treatment date. Continue to take medication

post treatment until all medication is finished.

2. Hydroquinone Start using the Hydroquinone up to two weeks prior to your procedure (if time permits).

Apply to a clean face twice daily (morning & night) prior to applying moisturizer. Use only a pea

size amount for each application.

Due to the amount of time dedicated to the CO2 procedure and the number of staff members involved, you are required to provide <u>48 hour</u> notice for re-scheduling or cancelation to avoid forfeit of your \$500 deposit or forfeit of your prepaid treatment.

The following instructions will help you prepare for your treatment day

- We are asking your body to produce an immune response. Please get plenty of rest and increase your nutritional intake of Vitamin C to boost your immune system. Increase consumption of green leafy vegetables for healing and lean proteins for collagen production.
- Avoid sun exposure or spray tans for approximately two weeks prior to your treatment. Wear a broad-spectrum sunscreen of at least SPF 30 to protect your skin.
- Patients who are pregnant, breast-feeding, have an active skin infection or active cold sore in the treatment area, or have been on Accutane within the last year cannot be treated.
- Stop applying any "irritating" skin products at least <u>one week prior to treatment</u>. These include prescription Retin-A and Glycolic Acids.
- Increase consumption of water starting 2 days prior to treatments (8 8oz glass/day). Drink at least 8 oz. of water right before
 your treatment.
- The doctor has written prescriptions for medications (see medication list) to be used before and after your laser treatment. Have these filled by your pharmacist and available the day of your treatment. Be sure to bring all prescribed medication to your laser appointment.
- · Eat a well-balanced meal a few hours before your laser treatment.
- Have someone available to take you home after your treatment if you are taking any prescribed pain or anti-anxiety medication.
- Arrive on time for your laser treatment with clean skin. Female patients should not wear any makeup/mascara, lotions, powders or perfumes on or around the areas being treated. Male patients can shave the morning of their treatment but should not apply lotions or aftershave on or around the areas being treated.
- If needed, bring your eye glasses. Contact lenses should be removed prior to treatment.
- Wear comfortable, loose fitting clothes and shoes. Button-front tops are preferable. Do not wear any jewelry on treatment day.
- Please expect to be at Harmony Skin & Wellness Clinic for 2-2½ hours.
- Refrain from using any products containing aspirin or any blood thinners for 7 days pre-procedure. You may use Tylenol if needed. See the sheet for a listing of products that will thin blood. (Over)

Products Required for Post-Treatment Aftercare

These products are discounted 15% and the total cost is \$110 plus tax.

Products to Discontinue

If possible discontinue blood thinners for **one week before your CO2 Ablative Laser procedure**. Aspirin, arthritis medicines, cold medicines, and other drugs containing aspirin cause excessive bleeding. The list below <u>is not a complete list</u> of aspirin-containing or otherwise prohibited products, so be sure to check all medications you might take in the one week prior to your procedure to see if they contain aspirin. If you're not sure contact your pharmacist.

NOTE: Do not take the following for **one week prior to your procedure** without checking with our office. If you have any questions, or are medically required to take these products, notify us or confirm with your doctor that it is okay to stop in anticipation of your procedure. Also, taking some of the listed herbal medications in low doses is okay, but please consult with your doctor.
