

Pre-Procedure Instructions for Permanent Cosmetics

1.	A \$100 deposit is required for all permanent cosmetic procedures (except for your second application appointment). To avoid forfeit of your deposit, please provide <u>48 hour notice for re-scheduling or cancellation</u> so that we may fill your time slot.
2.	Delicate Skin or sensitive areas may swell or redden; it is advised not to make social plans for the same day. Eyebrows and lip procedures may appear "crusty" for up to one week.
3.	Please arrive to your appointment without makeup on the face. Bring your favorite brow pencil, eyeliner or lipstick/pencils when having brow, eyeliner or lip procedures. This will help in the color selection process.
4.	Discontinue the use of <i>Latisse</i> * two weeks prior to your eyeliner procedure. (<u>Do not use <i>Latisse</i> in-between</u> this procedure and the follow up procedure). Wait 4 weeks after your final procedure to resume use.
5.	If you are currently taking daily aspirin or blood thinners, it is recommended that you stop these medications for 7 days prior to your procedure to minimize bleeding and/or bruising. Please consult with your doctor before stopping any medication regimen.
6.	If you have any condition that requires pre-treatment antibiotics before dental treatments, it is recommended that you follow the same use of pre-treatment antibiotics before all permanent cosmetic procedures.
7.	An antiviral prescription is required for anyone with a history of cold sores, fever blisters, canker sores or mouth ulcers when having the permanent cosmetic lip procedure.
8.	If you are having your procedure in the morning, avoid the use of caffeine products the day of your procedure.
9.	Do not take aspirin or ibuprofen prior to your procedure.

11. Tweezing or waxing should be done at least 24 hours prior to your procedure. Electrolysis and laser hair removal should be done at minimum of 7 days before your procedure.

10. Minimize the use of salt several days prior to your procedure. This will help minimize swelling post procedure.



12.	Remove contact lens prior to your eyeliner or lash enhancement procedure and do not re-insert until 24 hours
	later.
13.	Avoid wearing a white or light colored blouse the day of your procedure (pigment can splatter onto your clothing).

14. **Don't forget**: favorite make-up pencils, lipstick, eyeliner, sunglasses, contact lens solution, contact lens case, and eyeglasses.
