

Affirm Laser, elos IPL, BTL Exilis & Sublative RF

PRE-TREATMENT PRECAUTIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS

Reschedule Your Appointment If You:

- Have an <u>active cold sore</u> or have had one within 7 days of your treatment. The skin must be completely healed before your treatment.
- Have had prolonged or direct <u>sun exposure</u> two weeks prior to your treatment. Skin that appears tan or sun burnt will not be treated.
- HAVE INTENTIONALLY <u>TANNED</u> THE TREATMENT AREA(S) OR USED SUNLESS TANNING CREAMS (including spray-on chemical tans). You must <u>wait 2 to 4 weeks</u> before treating with the elos[®] IPL, Sublative, or Affirm Laser. You may be asked by the technician to reschedule a treatment if your skin appears to be darker than its natural color. Sun exposure decreases the effectiveness of the laser treatment and can increase the chance of post treatment complications.
- Are currently (or within 3 days prior to treatment) on any <u>photosensitizing medication</u> (i.e. minocycline) when having an elos IPL, Sublative or Affirm treatment.

Pre-Treatment Precautions:

- If you have a <u>history of cold sores</u>, you must start taking Acyclovir or Valtrex **before an Affirm or Sublative treatment or before an Exilis treatment on the lip/mouth area.** A preventative dose will be prescribed to prevent a cold sore or herpes breakout.
- Wear a SPF 30 (or higher) sunblock <u>daily</u> and re-apply every 2-3 hours. Your technician can assist you with recommendations.
- Discontinue any irritant topical agents (Retin A, glycolic and salicylic products, benzoyl peroxide, hydroquinone, prescription topical acne or astringents) 2 to 3 days prior to your treatment if you are having an elos IPL or Sublative procedures.
- A **Microderm** or **HydraFacial** may be performed prior to your first appointment. Ask your technician for information on scheduling these appointments in conjunction with your laser treatments.
- Patients who are pregnant, breast-feeding, have a pacemaker or internal defibrillator, impaired healing, metal
 implants or an active skin infection in the treatment area, or have been on Accutane within the last twelve months
 cannot be treated.
- Laser treatments may be scheduled <u>24 hours after</u> a **Botox**, **Dysport** or **Xeomin** treatment. Dermal Fillers should be scheduled <u>after your laser series is completed</u> to avoid breakdown of the product. **Inform your technician if you have Dermal Fillers in place.**
- Botox, Dysport or Xeomin may be injected immediately following an elos IPL and <u>1 week after</u> an Affirm treatment. Dermal Fillers may be injected <u>1 week after your final</u> Affirm, elos IPL, or Exilis procedure.

Day of Treatment:

- If treating the face, neck or chest areas: remove all makeup (including eye makeup) prior to applying the topical anesthetic (BLT). **Topical anesthetic is** <u>not needed for the Exilis procedure</u>.
- There should be no lotions, make-up, perfume, powder, or bath/shower oil present on the skin in the treatment area(s).
- Topical anesthetic (BLT) should be used only as directed by a physician/clinician for the **Affirm, elos IPL** or **Sublative** procedures. Anesthetic is applied to the treatment area(s) in a thin layer <u>one hour before</u> the procedure and again 10 minutes before your procedure time if needed. Your anesthetic will be ordered from a compounding pharmacy.
- You may take Tylenol immediately following your appointment. Please take the medication on a full stomach.
- Advise the treating technician if you have any dental crowns, caps, braces or other metal dental implants. These areas may be more sensitive to the treatment.
- Please expect to be at **Harmony Skin & Wellness Clinic** for **1-1** ½ hours depending on the treatment.
